Levine's Music. You may know that Levine composed and arranged many of the pieces played over the 20 years by Tapestry. So this concert will be special and joyous, in true Levine and Fran style. Levine Andrade's tragic death in November 2018, and Fran's a few years ago, is still felt by us who knew them as they had led such powerful music for us at these concerts for so many years.
