- residents must only meet with a maximum of one other person from another household outdoors

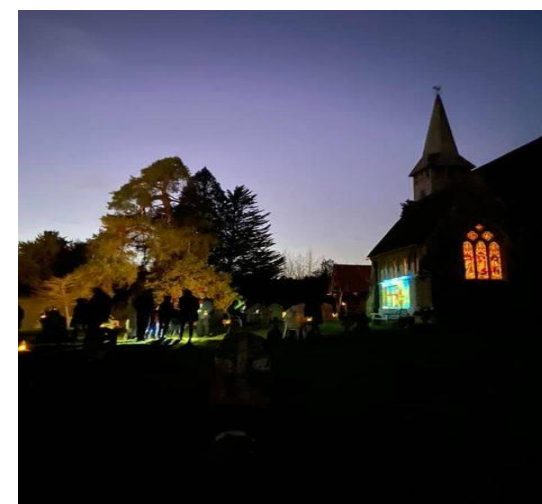
