AN INVITATION TO THE FIFTH GOSPEL

Holy Land Pilgrimage: 25th October – 3rd November 2021

A pilgrimage to the Holy Land of Christ's birth, ministry, death and resurrection has been described as being a Fifth Gospel. Certainly such an experience brings the Gospels alive in a way that nothing else can do and makes all the difference as we read or hear them read and as we celebrate the Christian year.

I am leading another pilgrimage to the Holy Land this year, postponed from last year, and there are some spare places. Six nights will be spent at an hotel overlooking the old city of Jerusalem and three in an hotel in Tiberias beside the Sea of Galilee. The itinerary includes Bethlehem, the Dead Sea, Qumran, Masada, Nazareth, Capernaum as well as the Church of the Holy Sepulchre and other sites in Jerusalem. It's a full programme but there is time for services, reflection and relaxation. We shall have a Palestinian Christian guide with us from the time we arrive at the airport until we depart from there.
