Congratulations to Pippa Cramer and Revd Bassi Mirzania, recipients of the 2021 Lambeth Awards for outstanding contributions to the Church and society.

Bishop Jo said: "It's a source of great delight to see two people in the Diocese of Guildford honoured in the list of those to receive Lambeth Awards from the Archbishop of Canterbury this year.

"The Revd Bassi Mirzania is recognised for her remarkable ministry, serving as informal 'chaplain' to the Persian/Iranian community, not only from Christ Church Guildford but far beyond. I have confirmed several people who have come to faith or been nurtured in the faith through Bassi and her work in networking across a community who might otherwise be isolated and vulnerable.

"Pippa Cramer has worked with another group of people who too often find themselves isolated and vulnerable: the elderly. Based at Holy Trinity Claygate she has enabled many to find faith and fellowship, and shared this ministry with churches elsewhere. With support from others last year she developed the DailyHope hotline, enabling people across the country to dial in for hymns and prayers so that those without internet could worship during lockdown.

"I thank God for Bassi and Pippa. Of the variety of different awards given by the Archbishop of Canterbury, both women have been awarded the Alphege Award for Evangelism and Witness. It is an inspiration to see how, with imagination and great determination, they have put to use the gifts and graces God has given them. Neither were offered 'a ministry' – rather each has pioneered a path in response to the needs and opportunities that presented, through which many have come to discover the blessings of God in Jesus Christ."
