

### Explore the Diocese

The Diocese of Guildford was formed in 1927 from part of the ancient Diocese of Winchester. Guildford Cathedral, dedicated to The Holy Spirit and built between 1936 and 1961, is one of only two British Anglican cathedrals to be built on a new site since the C16th Reformation - Liverpool is the other.

The Diocese covers an area of about 500 square miles, including most of Surrey and North East Hants, and touches on West Sussex and Outer London, with a population of more than a million people. The Diocese shares boundaries with the Dioceses of London, Southwark, Chichester, Portsmouth, Winchester and Oxford.

EE Telecommunications Mast  
Hascombe Estates have agreed Heads of Terms with WHP Telecoms. The lease is being negotiated with the solicitors at this time. WHP Telecoms will actually need to resubmit the planning application as they have reassessed the height of the surrounding trees following a survey, and will need an additional 5m of height in order to clear the foliage and provide the required level of signal.

## From Bishop Jo -IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT

To all dearly beloved parishioners of  
Dunsfold and Hascombe:  
I write to let you know that I have invited  
Ian to step back from ministry for  
approximately two months this summer, and  
he has willingly accepted this suggestion.  
This means that he will not be available to  
the parish for services or any other contact  
for the period beginning June 14<sup>th</sup> until (as  
currently proposed) 1<sup>st</sup> September. The  
period of leave will include two weeks of  
holiday. During this period the Area Dean,  
Roy Woodhams, will oversee ministry in the  
parish. I'm delighted to say that the Rev  
Rutton Viccajee, self-supporting curate at  
Cranleigh, is available and willing to cover  
most of the services as well as offer  
availability for pastoral care during this  
period. Their contact details will follow this  
weekend on the church website. I am aware  
that this news will land as a surprise to many  
in Dunsfold and Hascombe, and that you  
will miss your vicar just much as he will  
miss you! This period of leave is for  
personal reasons related to his wellbeing. I  
do not think it appropriate to say more than  
that and, out of respect for him, would ask  
you to resist speculation. Let me encourage  
you, rather, to pray for him and Susie during  
this time – for their wellbeing and  
flourishing. My hope and prayer is that this  
period of leave will set him up for many  
years of fruitful ministry ahead in  
Hascombe and Dunsfold
