

Keeping Safe. On July 19, 2021, most of the remaining Covid-19 restrictions ceased to be legally enforceable.

However, the Government, public health bodies, and the Church of England all continue to urge caution and have recommended that many of the restrictions continue voluntarily in order that they might provide safeguards.

We recognise that whilst some want a return to 'normality' as quickly as possible, others are anxious, and some are still unsure about even venturing out. Our move out of Covid-19 restrictions will therefore be considered and gradual. As we move forward, for the time being the following will be in place:

NHS Track and Trace - for those who wish to check in using the app, the NHS QR code is displayed in the church porch. If you wish to check in but don't have access to the app, you can sign in using the form on a table at the back of church.

Face coverings - you are encouraged to wear a face covering when moving around the building, and in particular are strongly urged to do so when coming to receive communion and singing hymns. Social distancing - we encourage you to be considerate of others in giving one another space.

The Eucharist - we will continue with distribution of communion in one kind only.
