### ARRIVA BUS UPDATE:

As you are aware, Arriva Kent & Surrey Ltd. is ceasing its bus operations in Surrey after 17 December 2021 and closing its depot in Guildford.

A proposal from another company to acquire the business did not reach maturity, therefore Surrey County Council has been working with other operators who have expressed interest in taking over the services, to ensure that vital key routes are maintained without any interruption.

Service 53: Guildford-Cranleigh-Ewhurst (Daily)

Service 63: Guildford-Cranleigh-Horsham

(Monday-Saturday) will continue to operate

Arriva also operate a service 'A' from Guildford town centre to the Royal Surrey County Hospital. This will cease after 13 November. However, there are frequent alternative services that can be used – Stagecoach service 1 and Safeguard services 4 and 5.

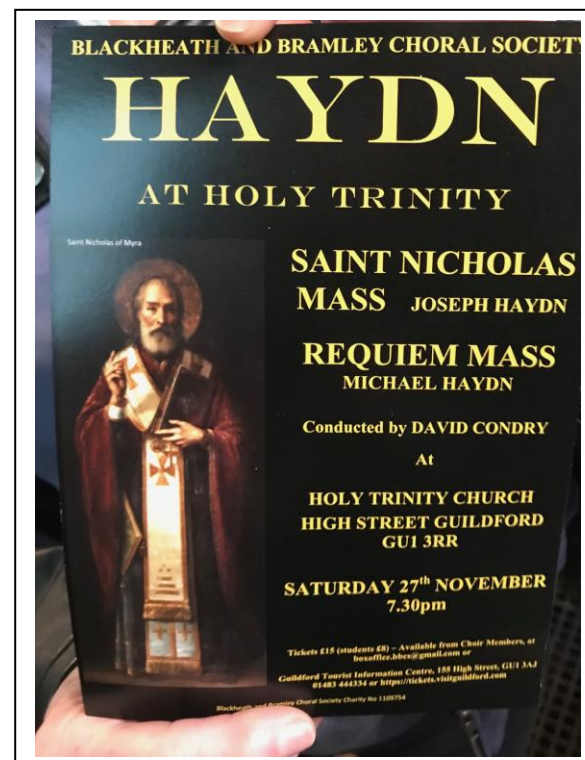
