Great news! As of March 30th, donations from Clubs to the Rotary District Ukraine Crisis Fund topped £100,000. What an achievement! - this has been reached in 3 weeks all due to your great efforts. Thank you. This week, we have agreed to send the following donations:
 £13,000 to Moldova to provide protein (meat) for 5000 refugees for a week
 £10,000 to Moldova to pay for the fuel and transport costs of a convoy of emergency aid from Spain
 £5,000 to the International Rotary Fellowship of Healthcare Professionals for urgent medical supplies into Ukraine and £5000 has been added to the reserve for Phase 3 applications from clubs when refugees start arriving in our District
