- Henry (Harry) Stevens Killed in action in the Somme, 1918, aged 18
- William Waller Killed in action in the Somme, aged 25
- Albert Berry Killed in action
- Alfred Bray Killed in action
- Percy Childs Killed in action
- Horace Hurlock Killed in action
- William Newman Killed in action

World War II

- Norman Botting Killed in action, 1940
- Lieutenant Colonel G.R. Pim, M.C. R.E. Torpedoed in Dunkirk, 1940, aged 44
- Ronald Whittington Killed in action, 1942
- Leonard Gould Gunner RAC, died of wounds in Italy, 1944
- Laurence McIntosh Killed in action, 1945
