LONDON MARATHON SUNDAY 23RD APRIL IN AID OF RP FIGHTING BLINDNESS (Registered charity no. 1153851 As some of you will recall Dinah and I have in the past organised various events to raise money to fund research into finding a cure for Retinitis Pigmentosa (RP). RP is a genetic disease of the eye, which results in the deterioration of vision, and often complete blindness. Our son Matthew has RP and is registered blind. To raise funds and awareness Matthew has entered this vear's London Marathon as a blind runner he will be running tethered to his great friend and training partner Gregoire They are hoping to complete the 26.2 mile course in under four hours.
