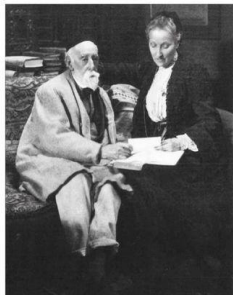
**Wine and Cheese Evening** Friday
