

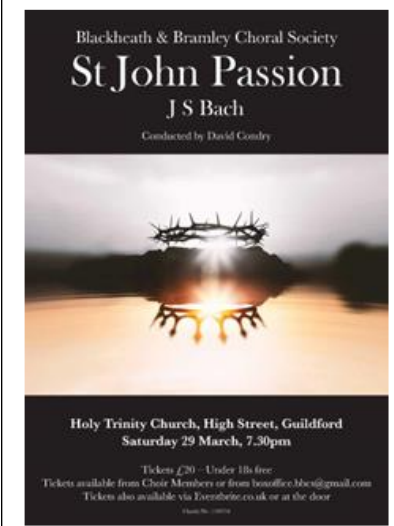
INVITATION to A CHARITY CONCERT
