- 1 More Lane GCB GH**  
A beautiful open view over Hascombe cricket pitch and the hills beyond. Stages, flowers, a pond and a clear view. Come and see our cottage garden and enjoy tea and cakes.
- 2 Bramble Cottage**  
**3 More Lane GCB GH**  
With a formal layout at the front transitioning to a more diverse and exciting space at the rear. Offers a variety of views with seating. Vibrant planting across a broad range of pollinators and insect collection.
- 3 Millery Cottage**  
**The Street GCB GH**  
Set a hillside in sight! Visit our garden of new babies. One half bordered by the stream with exposed/rocked planting; the other half is more formal with planned borders and flower beds.
- 4 Green Gardens**  
**The Street GCB GH**  
Built in 1800 on a hillside overlooking Hascombe Mill pond. A garden of changing levels directed by a running stream. Inset vegetable beds and herb beds used to hold back the pretty planting.
- 5 Fountains Cottage**  
**The Street GCB GH**  
Nestled in the heart of our community opposite the street. Hascombe Fountains. Our ordinary garden is a blend of vibrant flower borders, productive vegetable beds and a water pond. It is a little place of paradise.
- 6 Five Cottage**  
**The Street GCB GH**  
A quiet, sheltered, mostly 19th Cll, cottage garden in a tree-lined, flanked by mature trees. Mainly 19th Cll. Two ponds. Informal layout. Shrubs, ornamental grasses & roses.
- 7 High Leysmore**  
**Hascombe Road GCB GH**  
High on the hillside above the village of Hascombe stands a great oasis of tranquillity. Within the garden is the original residence of the wildcat owner Archibald Thomson (1860-1915). The planting complements the trees and creates a beautiful scene.
