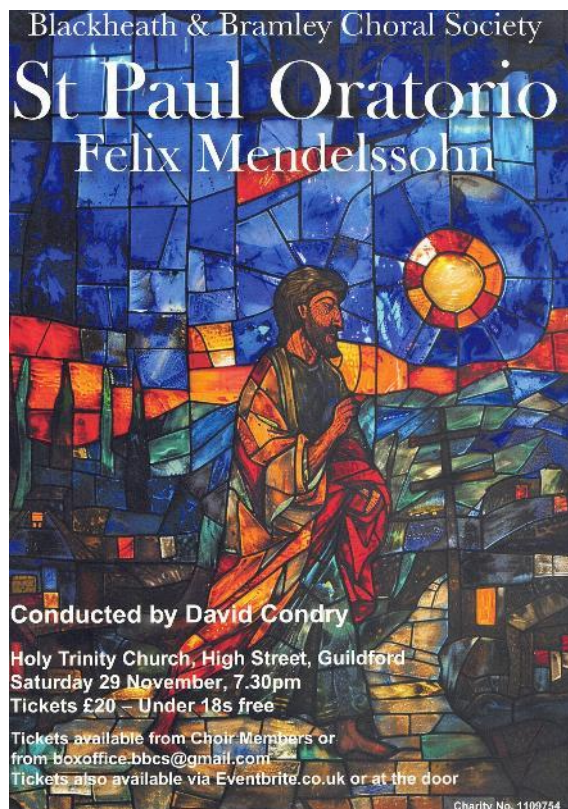




TIME TO REMEMBER SERVICE – SUNDAY 2ND NOVEMBER AT 4PM

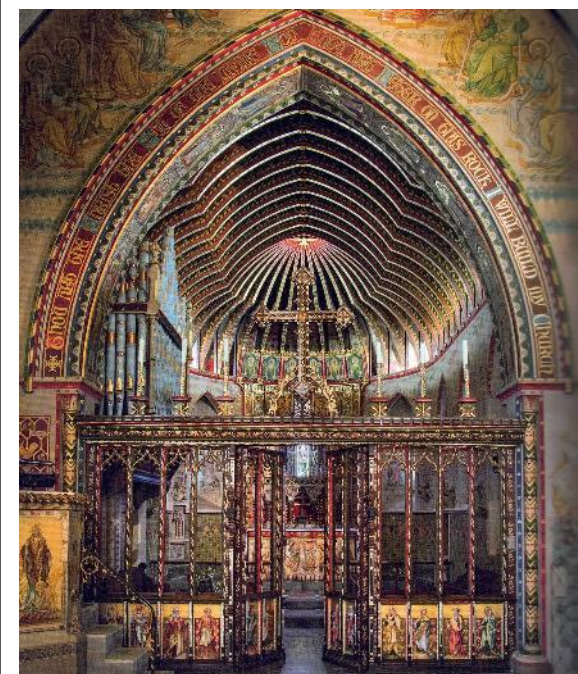
9th November Remembrance Sunday
