

IN THE EVENT OF A POWER CUT IN HASCOMBE THIS WINTER

We would like to alert you to the following measures that are now in place:  
Responding to residents' concerns, the Hascombe Parish Council (HPC) purchased a standby generator and arranged for the village hall electricity system to be modified so that it could be plugged in and used in the event of a power cut.

This means that if there is a village wide power cut, electricity will be available to power lighting, Wi-Fi, hot water, heating, and limited cooking facilities for villagers. If HPC becomes aware of a storm approaching, a warning will be issued on Facebook, with a statement as to when the power is likely to be restored by the generator to the village hall. This alert will also be issued to all on the Friends of Hascombe mailing list. This will be issued in tandem with a 'call to arms' by available members of the band of volunteers, who have all the necessary equipment and knowledge to ensure successful operation of the generator.

To give an indication of suggested timings, the volunteers will endeavour to have electricity at the Village Hall by 10.30 am, if there is an overnight power cut that persists. If there is a power cut during the day, the volunteers will endeavour to have the generator operational within one hour after the power cut. During the power cut, notices of further service will be posted on the door to the village hall and on the village noticeboard.

If anyone would like special assistance in the event of a power cut, please contact Norman Simpson on 208375 or 07775 710464 in advance, so that special measures can be put in place.




