I know that many of you will be concerned about the latest news that we have had to shut off the water supply to the Fountain, at least temporarily. The Fountain is a much-loved and special historic feature of the village and we will do all we can to keep the water flowing. Unfortunately, we are battling new rules introduced by the Drinking Water Inspectorate that we and Waverley must abide by. The simple fact is that the safety of the water cannot be guaranteed.

Waverley will enforce closure if we don't act, unfortunately brought to a head by the constant disappearance of the warning signs. We are looking into ways to impede collection, without having to put bars on the structure or turn the water off. But the water needs to be turned off until we can find a solution. We would be happy to hear from anyone with ideas or expertise in this area.
