Save our Fountain

The Hascombe Fountain Action Group has urgent information for your Attention

Hascombe Parish Council has turned off the water supply to the fountain following instructions from Waverley Council in respect of unfounded "water safety" concerns. The Hascombe Fountain Action Group need your help in getting the fountain turned back on as it was and **Not** as the Parish Council suggested at its last meeting i.e.

1. Caging the fountain so nobody can access it
2. Installing features to make the water 'safe' thereby altering the energetic structure of the water
3. Increasing the council tax precept for costs of water testing

We propose changing the listing of the fountain to a 'non potable' amenity and installing a permanent sign to this effect. If you agree, please join us.
