## HASCOMBE FOUNTAIN UPDATE

Since being instructed by Waverley, following direction from the Drinking Water Inspectorate (DWI), to shut off the fountain's water supply, the Parish Council has been working with Waverley to identify a way to restore it. The DWI has updated its requirements, and warning signage is no longer considered sufficient to protect public health. While it was hoped the water could remain available during this process, it was not possible to ensure that signage would remain in place, and the parish council was therefore instructed that the supply be turned off.

Two potential options are currently being considered:

- installing a structure to prevent the collection of water; or
- preferably, implementing measures to ensure the water meets drinking water standards.
