

I attended a meeting on Wednesday 22nd July of **Churches Together in Godalming & Villages**, at St John's, Farncombe. Talk & Discussion: 'Magnifica Humanitas'. Ian Honeysett from the RC congregation led a stimulating discussion about Pope Leo's encyclical issued in May. Ian outlined both the current development of artificial intelligence systems and the process that led to the publication of the encyclical. He summarised the main points of the document and the questions Pope Leo has posed for Christians as individuals and as communities of believers as to how we respond to this potentially dramatic change in economics, power, technology, and social interaction. We all noted how the encyclical puts humanity and its needs at the centre of all social and Christian endeavour and agreed how this needed to be stressed and argued for in a time of intense challenge. How the Churches engage with this is something we will need to carry on thinking and praying about. I am pleased to see in the Church Times that there has been a debate in the House of Lords, calling on the Government to discuss this important subject and to put in safeguards. Colin.
