A beautiful and very peaceful route around Hascombe Hill passing through Nore Hanger and Creek Copse. If you have the time I would recommend the extra "there and back" path to gaze at the modern stone circle. Make sure you also don't miss the sculpture at the top of Hascombe Hill fort and the stunning St. Peters church interior.

Many visitors assume a stone circle in Surrey is prehistoric, but local authorities have sometimes had to clarify that it is not an ancient monument but a modern construction.

The site at Hascombe Hill in Godalming, opened in the 1990s and was made of dragon stones and has become a point of interest for walkers, pagans and local historians.
