I am sure you will have seen the heartbreaking footage of the catastrophic flooding that has devastated the busy tourist crossing on the border of Tibet and Nepal.

The flooding has caused massive destruction, particularly across **Rasuwa and Nuwakot**. Thousands of people are missing, the death toll is rising by the hour, and countless families have lost loved ones, their homes and their livelihoods. Roads and bridges were swept away within seconds.

Relief efforts have reached the worst-affected areas and are working around the clock searching for survivors, but this will be a long and difficult process.
